#### **PAST DUE ACCOUNTS**

If an account becomes 2 months past due, the student will be subject to suspension from OCA until the account is current or approval is given from the administrator for a deferred payment plan. If the student remains suspended from the classroom for the period of one month, the student may be administratively withdrawn from the school.

If your account becomes 30 days past due twice in a semester the administration has the right to refuse re-enrollment the following semester. In such cases, an appeal letter will need to be provided to the School Board for approval of reinstatement prior to the start of the following semester.

Accounts must be paid in full for a senior to receive his/her diploma.

Outstanding accounts may have their records held until payment is made.

#### **LUNCH PROGRAM**

Lunches will be available to all students for purchase from our cafeteria. Each student will be assigned a student ID and lunches may be purchased using that ID. Money can be added to the account by bringing money to the school or online with the EZ Pay lunch program which can be accessed on our website. (Go to ocacrusaders.com; click on Student Resources; click on Lunches; click on the EZ chalkboard and that will take you to the EZ Pay sign up.) If you pay by credit card/on line we require a \$20 minimum.

Books will be purchased by the parents. The charges will be according to grade level. If a student loses a book, he/she is required to purchase a new one. Hardbound books are issued on a rental basis and remain the property of OCA, along with quizzes and testing materials.

The book fee includes a Yearbook.

A school agenda (planning organizer) is included in the 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade book and supply fee.

A testing fee to take the Explorer, PSAT, and PLAN tests is included in the  $9^{th}$  -  $11^{th}$  grade book and supply fees.

#### **TUITION**

#### Pre-School

K3 & K4 (per child) \$4,800

2 <sup>nd</sup> Child	\$660.00 per month; \$6,600.00 annually

4 <sup>th</sup> Child & Each Additional	Child\$540.00 per month; \$5,400.00 annually

All children must be living in one household.

Payments may be made in one yearly payment due by July  $1^{st}$ , two semester payments due July  $1^{st}$  and January  $1^{st}$ , or 10 monthly payments per year, beginning August  $1^{st}$  and continuing through May  $1^{st}$ . There will be a 5% discount for the yearly payment and a 2~%% discount for each of the two semester payments. The first semester includes August through December payments and the second semester includes January through May payments.

<u>Late Payments</u>: All monthly payments are due the first day of the month and considered late after the 10th. Any payment postmarked after the 10th is considered late and will be charged a \$10.00 late fee for every month a payment is not made by the 10th.

It is the responsibility of the parents to pay the tuition for their child/children on or before the  $10^{th}$  of the month. Monthly statements will be sent prior to the first of each month. Late fees will be added to the next month's statement for those having an outstanding balance.

Monthly tuition fees for students enrolled after July 1<sup>st</sup> or January 1<sup>st</sup> will be adjusted to reflect the student's entry date for that semester. The monthly tuition is required for any month that a student is in attendance for any school day of that month, whether enrolling or withdrawing.

#### **EARLY CARE**

7:00 - 7:30 AM - Fees per Child \$15.00 per month.

#### **EXTENDED CARE**

3:30 - 5:30 PM - Fees per Child \$3.00 per hour

All pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade students not picked up by 3:45 PM will automatically be placed in the appropriate Extended Care area. The student's account will be billed \$3 per hour per student in such a case.

#### **Extended Care Fees for staying late**

Children in Extended Care are required to be picked up before the closing time of 5:30 PM. If they are not, the following charges will apply:
