The deadline for applying is also quickly approaching; make sure to get this taken care of immediately.

UNIFORMS

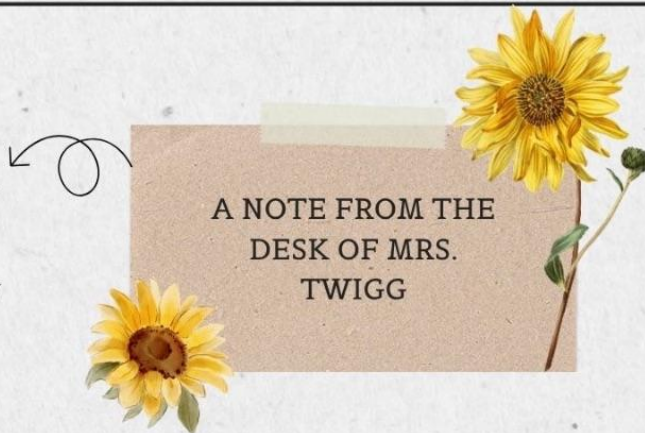
